Dear Komarek Parents/Guardians:

The Komarek Board of Education will, once again, sponsor Homework Class for students in grades 3-8. This year, we will simultaneously run three different programs. All programs will have limited availability.

Program #1 will be for students that qualify for additional supports in reading and mathematics as determined by our fall assessments and/or teacher recommendation. Permission slips for this program will be given to parents during October parent/teacher conferences. Additional spots will be reserved pending first trimester report card results. **This program will be smaller than in year's past.**

Program #2 will be reserved for students that do not qualify based on fall assessment data and/or teacher recommendation. Students enrolled in this section will report to the library after school. This section will have a maximum of 25 students. Certified staff will supervise students and high school National Honor Society members may be present to provide additional support. Permission slips for this program will be sent home on Monday, October 15th. **Permission slips will be due on Thursday, October 18th.** If necessary, a lottery for program #2 will be conducted.

Program#3 is reserved for students enrolled in Komarek's After Care program. All students in grades 3-8 attending After Care are eligible for this program. This class is run by our After Care staff. **Students in After Care do not need to complete a permission slip.**

Please see below for additional important details:

- The classes will begin on October 22, 2018 and will run through Thursday, May 9, 2019.
- The classes are held Monday-Thursday each week from 3:15-4:30 PM. Please note, there are several days during the year when class is cancelled. Parents will receive a complete calendar for Homework Class.
- Students not selected during the lottery (if necessary for Program #2) will be placed on a waiting list. As spots become available, a lottery will be conducted to add students to the program.
- Students are mandated to attend each session. Two unexcused absences may result in the student being dropped from the class.
- Behavior will be monitored closely. Students may be dismissed from the program for behavior infractions.
- All students and their parent must sign and agree to all conditions of the program prior to a student being placed in the class.
