Roberts' Rules of Order, Newly Revised, shall govern the Board of Education in its deliberations, voting and acts in all cases in which it is consistent with statutes of the State of New Jersey, rules of the State Board of Education, or these bylaws.

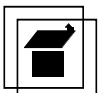
Presiding officer

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board. In case of absence, disability, or disqualification of the President, the Vice President shall act in his or her place; if neither person is present, another member of the Board who is selected by a majority of fellow Board members present shall preside. The act of any person so selected shall be legal and binding.
