Audience: Data Clerks

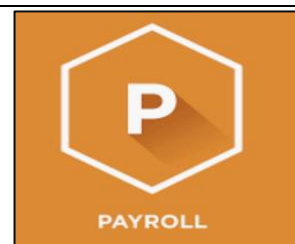
The correct ending date for data clerks is May 24, 2019, not May 28, 2019.
