We are excited to announce that Dartmouth Middle School will be hosting an Extended Learning Opportunity for students entering grades 6, 7, and 8. The summer session will focus on math intervention and enrichment. It's a great opportunity for students to work on foundational skills for math that will help them continue their success once the regular school year starts.

The target groups for this enrichment program are students who have made progress over this past school year, but could also benefit from additional exposure to grade level content.

There are three programs this summer:

- Summer Bridge- Open to all incoming 6th graders.
- Summer Intervention- Incoming 7th and 8th graders (current 6th and 7th graders) that need extra enrichment and/or intervention to prepare them for the upcoming school year.
- Summer Acceleration- Incoming 8th graders (current 7th graders) that are recommended by their Math teachers to participate in Honors Math in the upcoming school year. Students are selected based on GPA, MAP and SBAC scores, ***and*** teacher recommendation.

Although the application says "mandatory," the purpose is to offer students an engaging and enriching environment during the month of June to practice and refine their math skills, while also building their confidence. We understand that some students may not be able to attend based on prior plans made for the summer, but we would love to see as many of our students there as possible.

***Summer School will run from June 10 - June 28 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:20 p.m. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Seating is limited, and will be filled on a first come, first served basis, so we encourage you to return your application promptly.***
