The following students should report to the gym for testing: 9th grade fall, winter and spring athletes who are not enrolled in a PE class; 9th grade students not enrolled in a PE class; 10th - 11th grade students who have not passed five out of the six PFTs; and 10th - 11th grade students who have not yet taken any of the California PFTs.
