- Basic Calculator

- Package of highlighter pens with multiple colors (at least 4 different colors)
- 4 single subject spiral-bound notebooks (college or wide-ruled)

- 1 Dozen Pens (blue or black ink)
- 2 Red Pens
- 2 pack of wide rule lined paper (at least 150 sheets per pack)
- 1-2 Erasers (Stanford Magic Rub are great)
- 6 Dozens of No. 2 pencils, preferably **Dixon or Ticonderoga**--NO MECHANICAL PENCILS ALLOWED
- 4 packs of standard size index cards
- Personal pencil sharpener
- Pencil/pen pouch or box (NO BIGGER THAN 8" x 5" x 2")
- Set of colored Markers (fine point), such as Crayola
