The Texas Education Agency (TEA) requires school districts to notify parents of the requirements of the Public Education Grant (PEG) Program authorized under Texas Education Code, Chapter 29, and Subchapter G. In 2018 our Elementary is rated "Improvement Required" thus identified as a PEG campus.

As a result, the staff at our elementary has developed a comprehensive needs analysis and a targeted improvement plan that we believe will help us meet the needs of every student and improve our accountability rating in 2019.

As the parent or guardian of a student attending the elementary campus you have the option to request a transfer of your child to a campus in another school district for the 2018-2019 school year. If you apply for transfer to a neighboring school district, the district chosen is entitled to accept or reject the application for your student to attend school in that district but may not use criteria that discriminate on the basis of a student's race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status. If the application is accepted, the school district chosen may not charge the your student tuition. Sabinal ISD is not required to provide transportation to and from the school chosen by their parent or guardian.

Under the PEG program, a student can continue to be eligible for transfer until he/she completes all grades at the campus to which the transfer was approved, then your student would then return to Sabinal ISD.
