# PIONEER CAREER CENTER

The Pioneer Career Center gives LHS students the opportunity to explore 12 different career paths in a hands-on environment while earning college credit. Credits earned at the Pioneer Career Center may be used toward an Associate's Degree at KCKCC or other accepting institutions.

## Culinary Arts

Students will master the fundamental skills of food service in hotels, restaurants, hospitals, catering, etc. Opportunity to receive practical experience in food service preparation for public meetings and banquets.

## HVAC

Training is comprised of heating, ventilation, air conditioning, and refrigeration. Silver brazing, electrical and mechanical troubleshooting and sheet metal techniques are also practiced. Program approved for EPA and R-401A refrigerant certification.

## Construction Technology

Students will prepare for careers in plumbing, electrical, mason work, and carpentry. Eligible for CERT A after two semesters. Apprenticeship opportunities with more than 10 skilled craft unions.

## Robotics

Prepares students for technical jobs in the growing field of robotics, specifically focused on field work skills required to repair and maintain robotic machinery.

## Building & Property Maintenance

Teaches fundamentals of maintaining commercial property and apartments. Apprenticeship opportunities with more than 10 skilled craft unions.

## Criminal Justice

Provides insights to jobs related to criminal justice such as US Customs, private investigation, or working with a private police force. Instruction will prepare students for applications, exams, interviews, and background checks respective to this profession.

## Commercial & Residential Technology

Prepares students for entry-level positions working on in-home appliance repair. Detailed instruction on refrigerators, ranges, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, wall ovens, microwaves, and kitchen ventilation.

## Health Careers (CNA/M&T)

The CNA course will teach basic nursing care skills and concepts needed for the student to function as a nurse's aide. This course is authorized by the state of Kansas and upon completion, allows the student to sit for the nurse aide certification examination. The Medical terminology course is taught in conjunction with the CNA course and is designed to give the student a comprehensive understanding of the terminology used across all health care disciplines.

## Biomanufacturing

This two-semester certificate program with mix of classroom instruction from industry professionals and hands-on learning in small teams working with state-of-the-art biomanufacturing equipment.

## Office Assistant

The Administrative Office Professional Program is designed to give students a well-rounded preparation for a career in an office by providing knowledge and skills necessary to adapt to a continuously changing administrative work environment.

## Cyber Security

Introduction to topics of network security, threat prevention, and appropriate response to data breaches. Ideal for participants pursuing academic or technical degrees, and/or network security engineer or security technician certification.

## Electrical Technology

Program to develop basic electrical skills, technical knowledge, and related occupational information to prepare for initial employment in the electrical trade.
