- **Texas A&M University – College Station**

Deadline: December 1, 2018

Submit your application through [Apply Texas](#) or [The Coalition](#). The application you choose will not affect your admission decision. You can apply for all University level scholarships through the ApplyTexas or Coalition application. The scholarship deadline is December 1, 2018. - **The University of Texas at Austin**

Deadline: December 1, 2018

Submit your application through [Apply Texas](#) or [The Coalition](#). The application you choose will not affect your admission decision. By submitting the application by December 1, 2018 you will automatically be considered for the majority of scholarships awarded by the Office of Financial Aid. Visit

- **University of Houston**

Scholarship Priority Deadline: November 15, 2018

Complete the University of Houston application for admission using either [Apply Texas](#) or [The Common App](#). Submit just one application. The application you choose will not affect your admission decision.

- **Texas State University**

Scholarship Deadline: December 15, 2018

Admissions Deadline: March 1, 2019

Texas State offers three categories of academic scholarships for incoming freshmen. The [National Scholarships](#) and [Assured Scholarships](#) are automatically awarded to you upon admission, provided you meet certain minimum academic requirements. They also offer a number of Competitive Scholarships, which are

awarded on the basis of the overall strength of your scholarship application. To be considered for the competitive freshman scholarships you must meet [Assured Admissions](#) and complete a Texas State Scholarship application by December 15, 2018. The AXA Achievement Scholarship offers college scholarships of \$2,500, \$10,000 and \$25,000 to high school seniors who have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their activities in school, the community or workplace. Scholarship recipients are ethnically and economically diverse, but they share these qualities: ambition and drive; determination to set and reach goals; respect for self, family and community; ability to succeed in college. The 2018 program will be accepting applications until 10,000 applications are submitted or December 14, 2018, whichever comes first. Your application MUST be one of the first 10,000 submitted electronically by the deadline date, so **apply early!**

BOTH AN ACADEMIC AND A VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP ARE AVAILABLE!

Scholarships are available in the amount of \$3,000 (\$1,500 a semester). A limited number of vocational scholarships are also available in the amount of \$1,500. To retain his/her scholarship, the recipient must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA or 2.50 on a 4.00 scale.

- **ASVAB TEST**

DATE: The ASVAB Test will be administered in January, 2019.

The ASVAB is open to any 10th, 11th or 12th grader who wishes to take it. You can take it all three years if you wish to do so. If you are considering going into the Military it will help to retake it in order to get your score up. The ASVAB or Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery is not just for Military enlistment, but is a very good test to see where your aptitudes and abilities are for a vocation/career.
