Scholarship Background

Kristin Smart graduated from Lincoln High School in Stockton, California in 1995. She was a college freshman at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo in 1995-96. She was a young woman who embraced life, new adventures and looked forward to exploring the world, and working as an architect. Unfortunately, her dreams were lost when another student on campus abducted her. Kristin has never been found and has been missing for 22 years. Her family's hopes are to have her dreams and aspirations passed on to other young women. The female recipient of this scholarship should have aspirations similar to Kristin's, or be interested in a career in law enforcement or criminal justice in an effort to build safer communities.

Scholarship Criteria

- * Graduating **female** Senior, planning to attend a 2 or 4-year accredited college or university.
- * 3.25 or higher cumulative GPA
- * Interest in and evidence of Community Service
- * Interest in a Career in Architecture, Criminal Justice/ Law Enforcement or International Studies
- * Awardee must show evidence of acceptance to a 2 to 4-year college prior to accepting the award. In the event that awardee attends a California 2-year college, the award will cover actual tuition, fees, and books.

Scholarship Application Requirements

- High School transcripts including first semester of senior year.
- Two letters of recommendations in sealed envelopes.
- A recent color photo must be attached
- * A maximum 500-word essay explaining your interests, high school, and community service activities including an explanation of what you hope to study and what experiences have influenced your career interest. You may reference any financial or others needs if applicable to application.

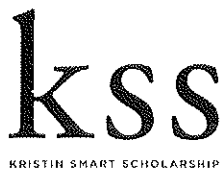
