Swartz Creek 9-12 Summer Session Attendance Policy

Swartz Creek High School will offer summer school to students in grades 9-12 in need of credit recovery. Summer school will begin on Monday, June 24th and end on Thursday, July 25th. Students enrolled in the summer school program will be required to attend one of the daily lab sessions listed below every day the lab meets:

Session A– 10:00am-11:00am

Session B– 11:00am-12:00pm

Session C– 12:00pm-1:00pm

Lab sessions will be held Monday—Thursday.

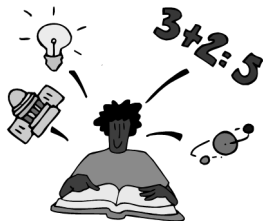
Due to the limited number of days that summer school is held, students are expected to attend their assigned lab sessions daily. Students who miss their assigned sessions and are unable to make it up will not earn credit or be given a refund.

All instruction for summer school courses will be acquired online using the Kickstand® eLearning platform. Students **ARE REQUIRED** to spend additional time beyond their scheduled lab session(s) to complete assignments. All final exams must be taken in the lab. All course work **MUST** be completed by July 25th for credit to be earned. We will have a math and science teacher available for students enrolled in math and/or science courses who are in need of assistance.

GPA CALCULATION:

All summer school classes receive a letter grade using the district grading scale. These courses will be recorded on the transcript under summer school 2019. All grades will count towards students' cumulative GPA.

We offer a wide variety of courses. See the list for more details. Enrollment begins now and continues through June 24th. 50% of the registration fee is due at the time of registration and the remaining balance is due by July 25th.



CLASSES OFFERED

Students enrolled in summer school will take courses through Kickstand®. Students may earn a maximum of 1.5 credits in summer school. Students **MUST** attend their daily lab sessions to show evidence of progress and to receive assistance. All course exams must be taken in the lab.
