*A part time student may opt to become a full time student at the beginning of any school year. At that time, the student will need to provide an official transcript that shows any credits earned outside of CSEC. After the Registrar transfers the courses onto the CSEC transcript, the student's full time grade level will be determined.

**Standardized Testing is required for all full time students. All CSEC students must come on campus on the designated testing days even if it requires the student to miss an off-campus college course.
