Fern Hollow Nature Center's 19th Annual Fall Music Festival

Great Music, Great People, Great Outdoors Join us on Saturday, September 21 from 4-8 p.m. (gates open at 3:30) at the Fern Hollow Nature Center, 1901 Glen Mitchell Road in Sewickley Heights for our annual fundraiser for environmental education, The Fall Music Festival.

Fun for the whole family, the Music Festival will feature Well Strung (an Americana, bluegrass group) and Corned Beef and Curry (a highly interactive band from Pittsburgh combining Celtic music with American Classic Rock). The festival also offers children's activities including mini-golf, face painting, obstacle course, scavenger hunt, and so much more. Plus, festival food from Las Chicas Mexican Food Truck and Sewickley Confectionery. Picnic and coolers are permitted.

Tickets for the festival are \$35 for adults and \$20 for children 5-17 years; children under 5 years are admitted free.
