Executive Summary:

On Wednesday, June 5th, one of the fourth grade teachers reported that one of the students from another fourth grade class was accusing one of his students of bullying. According to the target, the two offenders were talking/cursing behind him during a school event and the target turned around and admitted to telling them to "shut up". The target then said that the offender #1

threatened to beat him up and offender # 2 made fun of his hair, his race, and his backpack.

Offender #1 stated that he was talking (not cursing at the target) and that is when the target told him to shut up. The offender did not admit to cursing at him or threatening him. The offender did admit that after the target told him to shut up, then he said " Shut up idiot". Offender #1 stated that the target called him dumb and talks secrets about him. The target did not admit to talking secrets about them, however he said he looks in their direction and talks to his friends about how offender #1 and #2 bother him. The target did not admit to calling him dumb.

Offender #2 admitted to making fun of the target's backpack, however, did not admit to making fun of his hair and his race. Offender # 2 also stated that the target called him dumb.

There were no witnesses to the allegations that the target made against the offenders. The only findings were the allegations the offenders admitted to.

The administration spoke to all students and requested that they all keep a respectful distance between them.

On Thursday, June 7th, another fourth grade teacher took a drawing from offender #1 and he admitted to drawing a picture of the target and referring to him as being "restarted". The administration and parent had a conference in regards to the drawing.

Executive Summary:

On Friday, May 31st, the victim's parent reported that her son shared with a medical professional that he was being bullied in school. The following accusations were made:

Aggressor #1 admitted to taking the classroom box of crayons they were to be shared among two other students and not returning them. The aggressor also admitted to telling the victim that "she is not her friend" because he kept asking to borrow the markers that she was using. The aggressor realized that she should have just told him that she would allow him to borrow them once she was done.

Aggressor #2 admitted to ignoring the victim when he wanted to walk by himself during recess because he wasn't feeling well and the victim kept following him. The victim also accused aggressor of telling him that he is not his friend, however, the aggressor doesn't recall saying that.

Aggressor#3 admitted to telling the victim to be quiet and stop talking because he wanted to hear what the teacher was saying.

The victim did admit to continuing to ask aggressor #1 for her markers, following aggressor #2 during recess while he wanted to be left alone, and distracting aggressor #3 by talking while the teacher was teaching. All aggressors realized that they could have communicated their feelings in a more kind and respectful way and apologized to the victim and the victim also realized his role in the conflict through conflict resolution.

On May 10th the ABS initiated the interview and the target explained that she felt like she was being "left out" and that aggressor #2 was calling her names. The ABS interviewed all three aggressors:

Aggressor #1 -She said that she admitted to looking her way during lunch because she thought the target was talking about her, however, she said she never meant to leave her out, she actually invited her over, however, the target refused.

Aggressor #2 - She admitted to calling the target "dumb" because they were arguing over the answer to a math problem and she felt angry at the target.

Aggressor #3 - She admitted to "rolling her eyes" at the target because she said the target looked at her in not a nice way, and also not inviting her over when she invited others because she said the target wasn't speaking to her. The target also admitted to saying that it is better when aggressor #3 wasn't at school when Aggressor # 3 was absent one day.

All students came together for conflict resolution and apologized to each other. In addition to the above accusations, the target also was struggling with that fact that she told another student that she liked another student and somehow it got back to the other student who she liked and he approached her which made her feel embarrassed and disappointed in her friend who she trusted.
