


Weekly Memos – April 22, 2019

English/Language Arts, Math and Social Studies tests will be administered via paper and pencil. Science is a field test and will be administered online for grades 5-8. Students in grade 2 will test in ELA and Math beginning April 22. Students are encouraged to arrive at school on time each day, bring #2 lead pencils and do their best.
