Middle School General Information 2019-2020

- Average class size is 17.
- Honors courses are offered in 6th-8th Language Arts, 6th-8th Mathematics, and 8th Science.
- All students must complete 8 hours of Christian service through their Bible class. (4 per semester).
- All students attend chapel services on Wednesday of each school week.
- Parents and students have easy access to lesson plans, homework, conduct, and grades through RenWeb.
- Parent/Curriculum Nights for 6th-8th grade are offered in August.
- Technology is integrated into the classroom through the use of smart boards, Google classroom, and various web-based instructional tools.
- 7th & 8th grade students are able to participate in BYOT (Bring Your Own Technology).
- MERIT Program is available for students with diagnosed learning differences.
- ACT Aspire Testing is administered 2 times during the year in English, Reading, Math, and Science.
- Students may participate in clubs including Jr. Beta, Duke TIP, Math in Action, and Aviation, as well as Bible studies.
- Students compete in ACSI Competitions for Fine Arts, Math Olympics, Spelling Bee, and Writing.
- Full athletic program is available to middle school students including:
 - Fall – Cross Country, Girls Fast Pitch Softball, Girls Volleyball, Football, and Cheerleading.
 - Winter – Wrestling and Girls & Boys Basketball.
 - Spring – Baseball, Boys Lacrosse, Tennis, and Track & Field.
- Fine Arts electives include Art, Band, or Chorus for 6th-8th grades. Additionally, 7th graders may elect to take Drama and 8th graders may elect to take Drama or Guitar.
- 7th and 8th grade students attend a spiritual emphasis week in September at The Wilds Retreat and Conference Center in North Carolina.
- 6th grade students have the opportunity to attend the Creation Museum/Ark Encounter historical/Biblical 3-day field trip to Kentucky.
- 7th grade students have the opportunity to attend the Holy Land Experience field trip to Orlando.
- 8th grade students have the opportunity to attend the Washington D.C. historical/cultural 4-day field trip.
