Boys & Girls Track – Both teams had success at their league opening meet Thursday at University, with the Boys posting wins over University and Gonzaga Prep while the girls defeated the Titans, but lost to the Bullpups. Saturday, we had teams in Pasco and at SFCC for Invitationals.

Girls Highlights: Pasco Invite – 10th place Team Finish. Jessica Dundas** – 200m – 9th; **Shannon Sullivan, Milana Zavlavsky, Aubrey Springer & Dasha Pankova** – 4x100m Relay – 3rd; **Ashlynn Eggleston** – Shot Put – 5th; **Haley Correll** – Javelin – 9th; **Zoey Thompson** – High Jump – 3rd; **Mason Carter** – Long Jump – 6th & **Hayley Smith** – Triple Jump – 10th.

Boys Highlights: Pasco Invite – Jonathan Baird, Jason Terrell, Kolby Blackler & Cayden Miller – 5th in the 4x400m Relay; **Nathan Puletasi** – 10th in the Shot Put & 7th in the Discus. **Nike-Van Kuren Invite: 6th place Team Finish – Evan Wiersma** – 100m – 6th, 300m Hurdles – 6th, Javelin – 9th; **Caleb Shawen** – 200m – 8th; **Calvin Word** – 400m – 5th; **Cooper Osborn** 2K Steeplechase – 3rd; **Elliot Williams** – 2K Steeplechase – 5th; **Connor Jones** – Javelin 7th; **Parker Startin** – Triple Jump – 4th.

Baseball – The guys swept Ferris, 5-3 & 10-0 but Shadle Park snapped their 4-game win streak on Friday with a 5-3 win at Mead. **Braeden Cordes** had 4 hits and 5 RBIs in the series with Ferris.

Soccer – Mead split overtime games with Lewis & Clark and Ferris last week. Wednesday, **Noah Taigen** made 2 saves in the shootout win over the Tigers. Friday against Ferris, **Carson Tucker** scored late in the 2nd half to tie the game, but the Panthers gave up a late goal in the second overtime period and lost 2-1 to the undefeated Saxons.

Softball – League play got underway a day late and the girls went 1-2 with losses at University (11-0), a win over Central Valley (5-4) and a tough loss to Lewis & Clark (7-5). In Thursday's win over the Bears, **Grace Sykora** threw out a runner at the plate in the 5th inning and homered in the 6th to help Mead get the win.

Girls Golf – The girls had quite the week. Tuesday, they won the Pasco Invite. **Cami Culp** (79) finished 3rd and **Charlotte Bloom** shot 80 to finish 4th. Wednesday they tied Lewis & Clark for the Tournament Title at the Palouse Ridge Invite – **Charlotte Bloom** shot 79 for the low score of the day. Then Friday at Esmeralda, Mead took 1st in the GSL opener with **Culp's** 71 the low score and **Charlotte** and **Libby Bloom** tied for 4th shooting 81.

Boys Golf – the boys placed 3rd at Esmeralda – **Zane Mularski's** 73 had him tied for 3rd. Thursday Mead placed 4th at the Palouse Ridge Invite – **Tanner Graybeal's** 75 was the low round for the Panthers

Boys & Girls Tennis – Weather wiped out Tuesday's matches with Ferris, but both teams went 2-0 in their league matches last week. The boys defeated Central Valley, 4-3 on Wednesday and Rogers, 7-0 on Thursday. The girls beat the Bears 6-1 and the Pirates 7-0. They are scheduled for three matches this week in an attempt to get "on schedule" as they near the end of the regular season. Both teams competed in the *shortened* Tri-City Invite this weekend. Results: The **Boys & Girls** combined to place 3rd out of 16 participating teams. **Carley Menner** was #4 Singles Champion, while **Sophie Koehler** (#1), **Luca Mistereck** (#2) and **Phoebe Milatz** (#3) were all semi-finalists. **Carley** was named the Girls' **Friday Player of the Day**, losing only 1 game in her 3 matches! **Andrew Wallace** was #4 Singles Champion and the doubles team of **Noah Barnes & Tyler Davis** made the semifinals.
