

Rogers High School Exemption Procedure 2018-2019

The purpose of the Exemption Policy is to encourage and recognize students for maintaining a good standing in academics, attendance, and behavior. Students must qualify for an exemption in each class for each semester. They are eligible for exemption in every class. Final discretion will be left to the campus principal. The following guidelines will apply:

- Grade/attendance requirements:
 - Semester grade 70-79; no more than 1 absence
 - Semester grade 80-89; no more than 2 absences
 - Semester grade 90+; no more than 3 absences
 - 4 tardies in a period will equal 1 absence for that class
- An exception will be given for absences due to bereavement (death of an immediate family member not to exceed 3 days).
- Students must have reached the Satisfactory Academic Performance Level on the previous STAAR EOC assessment in the given content area. If there is no state assessment for the given content area, this guideline will be excluded.
- Students will lose eligibility with a DAEP or AEP placement or days served during the semester.
- Students may not have more than 3 days assigned in ISS or OSS during the semester.
- Students taking their AP exams earn an automatic exemption in that course in the Spring Semester.
- A student having 10 or more unexcused absences in any one course will lose all exemption privileges.
- All lunchroom charges must be paid in advance.
