

## Concordia Parish Schools Online Credit Recovery Summer Program

Concordia Parish School Board students in grades 6-12 who need to make up academic credits this summer may participate in Concordia's online learning program. Concordia Parish Schools is partnering with EdOptions Academy to provide engaging online content that can be accessed from any computer with internet access.

**What is it?** This online program is for repeat credit only. Each course is broken in to two semesters. Students will need to take both semesters in order to receive full credit for the course. Each semester is \$80, for a total of \$160/course. Students may complete their coursework at home or any location that provides Internet access. Computer labs will be available at Ferriday High School and Vidalia High School beginning May 30<sup>th</sup>. Computer lab hours will be Monday-Thursday from 7:30 am-2:30 pm.

**What can I expect?** Upon receipt of payment, you and your student(s) will receive website login and password information. Once they log into their account, there is a pacing guide that will help keep them on track! Their state certified teacher will be available to help answer questions and keep them motivated. Parents will have access to student progress and communications through an easy to navigate student information system.

**What do I need to do?** In order for students to finish all course work before school starts in August, students must begin class on May 30. There is a link to register for classes on our district webpage. Go to [www.cpsbla.us](http://www.cpsbla.us) and click on the "Credit Recovery Registration" link. Once you've registered you will need to pay \$80 for Semester A. Payment can be paid at your child's school on Friday, May 24 from 8 am – 2:30 pm and Tuesday, May 28 from 8 am – 12 noon. Cash only. Once classes begin, there will be no refunds.

## 2019 Concordia Parish Schools Credit Recovery Information

- **Students can enroll on Friday, May 24 from 8 am to 2:30 pm and on Tuesday, May 28 from 8 am to noon at the student's school.** Enrollment instructions can be found on the [district webpage](#) or contact your school's guidance counselor.
- Once you register and are placed in a class, both the student and guardian(s) will receive an email from a [donotreply@bocavox.com](mailto:donotreply@bocavox.com) email account with a link to the website, their username and password. If an email is not received, please check your spam/junk mail folder. If you still have not received it, please contact EdOptions Academy at 1-800-447-5286.
- Parents: You can access your child's progress/grades at any time by logging in to your account. You are encouraged and expected to monitor their student's progress in their online course. *(Parents: You will need an email address for the teacher to contact you. If you don't have one, you can create free email accounts at Gmail or Yahoo.)*
- Students will be placed in a class with a certified teacher. This teacher will post office hours and an email that you can use to ask questions about the class and/or assignments.
- Courses will be taken online. Students may complete their assignments at home or wherever there is Internet access.
- Each class is divided in to 2 semesters (Semesters A & B). Semester A will begin on May 30, 2019. Semester B will begin on July 3, 2019.
- There is an online End of Semester exam that students must take at the end of each semester. This exam will be taken at the Concordia Parish Media Center. You will be notified if the location changes for any reason. Both exams will begin at 8 am.
- Semester A End of Semester test will be given on June 26. Semester B End of Semester test will be given on July 30, 2019. Both tests will be given at 8 am. Failure to take the end of semester exam will result in a failure of the class. Upon successful completion of Semester A, you will need to register for Semester B. This will be another \$80 fee. You will come by the CPSB office and pay \$80 to begin Semester B.
- Upon completion of the entire course, final grades must be submitted to your school guidance counselor. Students must maintain an overall average of 67% in order to receive credit for the course. The final day to turn in grades and receive credit for the course is August 7, 2019. **It is the student/parent's responsibility to make sure the school guidance counselor has the student's final grades.**
- If you encounter any problems/questions while taking the course, you must contact your EdOptions teacher directly.
- Plagiarism and any other forms of cheating are prohibited. Students who violate these terms will lose the opportunity to take other online classes in the future.
