All of our schools will remain closed until April 8th, 2020. We will continue to provide breakfast and lunch each day from 8:30 – 11:30 at King City High School and Greenfield High School. School offices will be open from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, however the staff will be significantly reduced so please call ahead to make an appointment if you need to speak to someone.

Teachers will begin to contact students to assign work over the next two weeks as we build and refine the virtual and packet methods to continue students progressing toward graduation.
