

# FOOD EMPLOYEE HEALTH POLICY

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Food Employee Illness Reporting Policy is to ensure that all Food Service employees notify the Manager or other "person-in-charge" (PIC) when they experience any of the conditions listed so that appropriate steps are taken to preclude transmission of foodborne illness or communicable diseases.

## POLICY

Oneida Special School District is committed to ensuring the health, safety, and well being of our employees and students and complying with all Health Department regulations. All Food Service employees shall report if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms to their PIC:

- Diarrhea
- Fever
- Vomiting
- Jaundice
- Sore throat with fever
- Lesions (such as boils and infected wounds) containing pus on the fingers, hand or any exposed body part, regardless of size.

Food Service employees should also notify their PIC whenever diagnosed by a healthcare provider as being ill with any of the following diseases that can be transmitted through food or person-to-person by casual contact such as:

- Salmonellosis
- Shigellosis
- Escherichia coli
- Hepatitis A virus, or
- Norovirus
