We are also requesting that you refrain from food deliveries to the school from outside vendors. The new lunch program has many more options. These deliveries are a burden to our staff.

Please adhere to the rules and procedures for drop off in the morning. Cars should pull up and drop off. No parent should pull over and get out. If you want to walk your child to the line, park. Drop off works well when all follow the procedures. Also, DO NOT let students out on the left, they then have to cross either in front of or behind the cars. Thank you.

Remember, tomorrow is a full day of school. Our children will attend Mass at 9am. Parents are always welcome.
