Introduction to Woodworking with Korbin Shearer

Intro to woodworking will take you from rough lumber to finished project. The course will cover shop, machine, and tool safety, project plan interpreting, cutting and milling wood stock, basic joinery, assembly, and finishing. Participants will have the option of learning to use the laser engraver as well. The cost of this course includes materials needed to build a bread/cheese board and jewelry box.

Simple Ring Making with Norman Ed

Learn the basics of jewelry making by making a simple band ring. Use the jeweler's frame and saw blades to cut a simple band. Learn to safely use the acetylene torch to anneal and solder the band. Learn to create a mirror polish using the proper abrasives and the buffing machine. The cost of the course includes the materials needed for the course.

Relief Printing with Mike Begenyi

Learn to make relief prints using linoleum blocks and oil based printing ink. Students will have the opportunity to make one color prints and learn the reduction block technique for printing images in more than one color and will leave the course with two editions of prints. Demonstrations will also include using laser technology to create printing blocks. The cost for this course includes the materials required.
