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INCREASED PROTECTION FOR DOE ACCOUNTS

On November 5, the DOE will launch a new password reset tool to make DOE information more secure. After the reset tool launches, DOE staff will need to set up three security questions from a list of ten to reset their passwords. The security questions can be set up via the Profile and Password Management tool on or after November 5, or whenever the current password expires. After setting up the security questions, you will be able to reset passwords without technical support by correctly answering your security questions. PER-SESSION OPPORTUNITIES FOR SCHOOL STAFF

Scoring for January Regents will take place between January 22 and 27. Note that Algebra I, Algebra II, Chemistry, Earth Science, English Language Arts (ELA), Global History, Living Environment, Physics, and US History will be scored partially or fully through per-session opportunities that will be centrally-funded and managed. Teachers and supervisors may apply for per-session positions at Regents scoring sites which began on October 9, until **November 16**.
