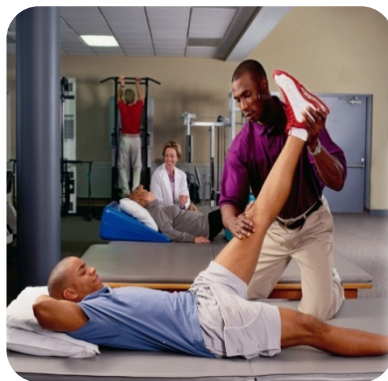

Courses

6350HS Health Services 1 Intro

Elective Grades 11, 12

Credit: 0.5 - Honors Credit

Prerequisites: Health 1

This course integrates the knowledge and basic skills of a health care worker with exploration of health careers. Course topics include: CPR Certification including – Adult CPR renewal, Child and Infant CPR, and AED certification; Health Care History; Health Care Facilities; Health Care Worker Personal Qualities/Traits; Health Care Career Exploration/Job Shadows; Medical Terminology.

6360HS Intro Health Services 2



Elective Grades 11, 12

Credit: 0.5 HHS Honors credit with 3 BMCC dual credits possible with successful course completion of Intro to Health Services 1 & 2

Prerequisite: Intro Health Services 1

This course integrates the knowledge and basic skills of a health care worker with human anatomy. Course topics include: First Aid Certification, Employability Skills, Cardio-Respiratory Systems, Vital Signs, Digestive System, Sensory Systems, Health Promotions, and Volunteer Service.

- ✓ 1.5 credits from required courses and at least 1.5 credits from optional offerings
- ✓ Complete application and turn in prior to deadline. **Deadline for 2018 seniors is March 22, 2018.**
