Dear Parents and Community Members,

I am pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2016-2017 educational progress for Princeton Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Justin R. In addition to the state awarding Princeton Elementary **REWARD** status for the 2013/14 school year, in 2015/16, the National Title 1 Association recognized Princeton Elementary as the Category 1, Part A, Award winner and one of only two schools in the state of Michigan recognized as a **National Title 1 Distinguished Schools** at both the State and National Levels. This distinction recognizes that Princeton Elementary has shown exceptional student performance for two or more consecutive years and has successfully exceeded our targets in Reading and Mathematics on state and local assessments.

Princeton Elementary has always met our Annual Yearly Progress (AYP). While the state did not formally report AYP results for 2014-15, we are pleased to report that in 2015-16, 2016-17, we not only met, but exceeded all state averages in all core content areas, as well as meeting or exceeding schools within our local demographics. While we are pleased with our results, we, as always, are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort. State law requires that we also report additional information.

Resident pupils within the Princeton boundaries are assigned to Princeton Elementary School. External and internal Schools of Choice students are also accepted at Princeton, according to seat availability. Information about enrollment procedures is available at the Lakeview District Central Office, which is located at 27575 Harper Ave. The phone number is 586-445-4000, ext. 2504.

In compliance with State of Michigan mandates, Princeton Elementary has developed a School Improvement Plan which is revised, evaluated and implemented annually. Our school's goals focus on the areas of reading, writing, math, science and social studies.

Over the past 5 years, including both 2017-18 conferences, our parent participation rate has remained over the 95th percentile.
