### Story Time at Searles or Hillview Crest Elementary Schools

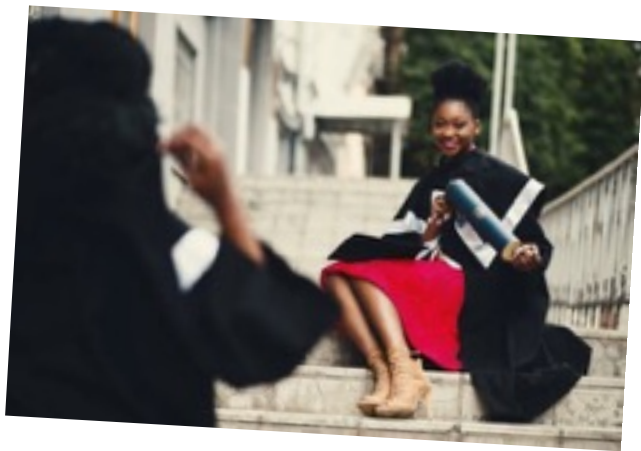

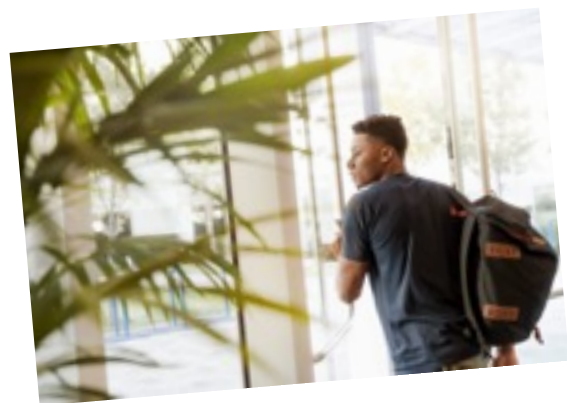


### DAAA College Night, 9-11<sup>th</sup> Graders
