Summer reading is REQUIRED for all students at St. Mary's High School

All juniors will be reading **Enrique's Journey (The Young Adult Adaptation): The True Story of a Boy Determined to Reunite with His Mother** by Sonia Nazario.

***Juniors registered to take 1818 Junior Literature/Composition (ACC English) will be reading one additional book. See reverse side for directions and assignments.**

Book description:

It is the true story of Enrique, a teenager from Honduras, who sets out on a journey, braving hardship and peril, to find his mother, who had no choice but to leave him when he was a child and go to the United States in search of work. Enrique's story will bring to light the daily struggles of migrants, legal and otherwise, and the complicated choices they face simply trying to survive and provide for the basic needs of their families.

After reading *Enrique's Journey*, all students will be given a plot test during the first full week of school. The test will be given in English and will be the first grade of the 2018-2019 school year. Students are encouraged to take notes while reading the book. These notes may be used by the student when he takes the test. All notes must be handwritten. **Typed notes of any kind will NOT be allowed to be used on the test.**
