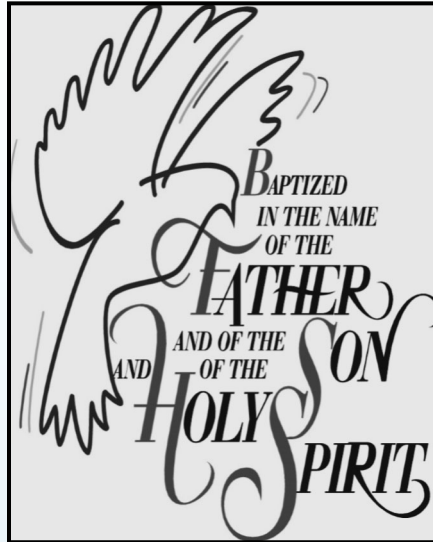

It is also a day to ask God for strength to take on the responsibility of sharing that faith with others.

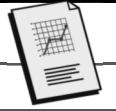

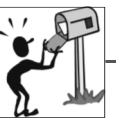

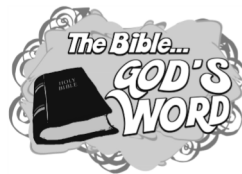
