

DHS Prom 2019: Frequently Asked Questions {updated with location & details}

General Information

1. Who can attend prom?	1. All Duluth HS Juniors and Seniors are invited to attend the Prom each spring; the Junior Class hosts the Prom for the Senior Class. Each DHS Junior and Senior must have paid his/her JUNIOR DUES in order to attend the Prom. {This is separate from your Senior Dues.}
2. When is Prom 2019?	2. The prom is Saturday, April 27 th at 7pm. The DHS Prom will end promptly at 11:00pm. Your ride must be at (the site) to pick you up by 11:00pm.
3. Where is Prom 2019?	3. The site will be revealed in March.

Junior Dues

4. How much are Junior dues?	4. Junior dues are \$100 through March 10 th and will increase to \$125 on March 11 th and again on March 27 th to \$150; you must pay at MyPaymentsPlus.com through April 9 th . Students must pay their dues at MyPaymentsPlus.com. <i>Please note that once Junior dues have been paid, they are non-refundable and non-transferrable.</i>
5. Where do I pay dues?	5. You may pay dues at <i>MyPaymentsPlus.com</i> through April 9 th .
6. What is the last date to pay Junior dues?	6. The last day to pay Junior Dues is Tuesday, April 9 th .

Date Tickets

7. How much is a Date ticket?	7. <i>Date tickets are \$50 each; you may only purchase one.</i>
8. When do tickets go on sale?	8. Your date must have a photo identification at prom. Please revisit this site for detailed information re: dates in February.
9. How many tickets may I purchase?	9. Each Junior or Senior who has paid his/her dues will be allowed to bring one (1) date.
10. What if my date is a Junior or Senior at Duluth High School?	10. If your date is a Junior or Senior at Duluth HS, s/he must pay (or have paid) his/her Junior dues in order to attend the Prom.
11. Who needs a date ticket?	11. You will need to purchase a Date ticket, if your date is a freshman or sophomore at Duluth High School or if your date does not attend Duluth High School. <i>If your prom is 21 or older, s/he must meet with a Duluth HS administrator prior to the 2018 Prom. If your date is from another high school we must have a conduct from completed by his/her home school (counseling or administration). Please see Mrs. Glaser for the form.</i>
12. May I switch or sell my ticket?	12. You may NOT! Ticket numbers are recorded by student names. At the Prom, only the official ticket holder will be admitted to the dance with his/her ticket and photo identification.

13. What is the Prom dress code?	13. LADIES – NO LOW CUT, TWO-PIECE, SEE THROUGH, BARE-MIDRIFF, EXCESSIVELY REVEALING (FRONT AND/OR BACK) OR SHORT DRESSES WILL BE ALLOWED. {Sneakers and tennis shoes are not allowed.} If you think your dress is in violation of this dress code, please bring a picture
