Dear Owasso Parents,

Owasso Public Schools is a thriving district committed to an exceptional education for its students. We are fortunate that our community invests in quality facilities in which its children learn. Currently, we have eight elementary schools in our district - Ator, Bailey, Barnes, Hodson, Mills, Northeast, Smith, and Stone Canyon. Our ninth elementary, Morrow Elementary School, is currently under construction and scheduled to open in August of 2019.

With the construction of Morrow Elementary, we have the opportunity to redistrict our elementary boundaries. This redistricting effort will provide relief from schools that have larger enrollments. It will also provide a window to examine our boundaries with the goal of children being served as close as possible to their homes.

This review of boundaries is being done by twenty-four parents who are volunteering their time and expertise to make this a project of excellence. Three parents from each of our current elementary schools were recommended by the principal to serve. The district has hired a demographer to analyze the current enrollment data and provide information to the redistricting team.
