**Bronze sponsors** will get the recognitions and opportunities listed above. \$200

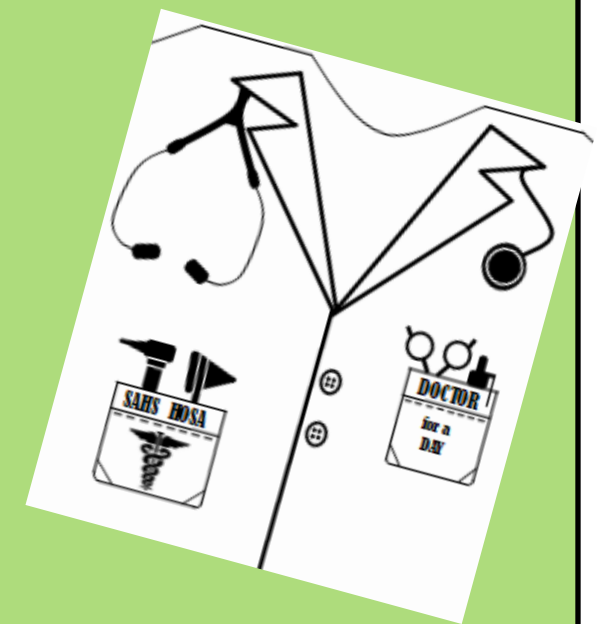
**Silver sponsors** will also have their **business or name listed on the back of the T-shirt.** \$300
