

Pre-K 3 through Kindergarten Transfer Student Process

Eagle Academy Public Charter School is excited to welcome new students who transfer to our Pre-K3 through Kindergarten program from other schools and centers. If your student is transferring from a Head Start program, please indicate that information on your enrollment form. We will ask for the name of the Head Start location as well. If you are unsure whether your student's programming was funded by Head Start, you can indicate that you 'do not know' and we will find out for you.

If your student is transferring from Head Start, please give the Registration Advisor a copy of your student's "transition packet" from Head Start. Students transferring to Eagle Academy Public Charter School will be asked to supply all of the necessary documentation for enrollment, which includes: health forms, dental forms, proof of residency, and (if applicable) IEPs/504 Plans. In some cases, we may seek additional information from families.

Transfer students must follow all the expectations in our Parent/Student Handbook, which includes uniform policies, toileting policies, attendance, and behavior expectations. Eagle Academy Public Charter School wants to ensure a seamless transition for our new Pre-K3 through Kindergarten students. Families will have an opportunity to meet teachers before school officially starts and are encouraged to attend our Early Childhood (Pre-K3 through Kindergarten) orientation. All students attending Eagle Academy Public Charter School receive baseline assessments to pinpoint what each student has already mastered in math and literacy. Teachers will use this information to support your child's academic growth as well as meeting academic benchmarks.
