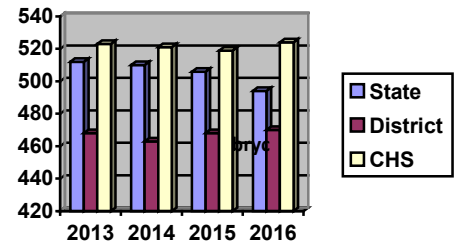

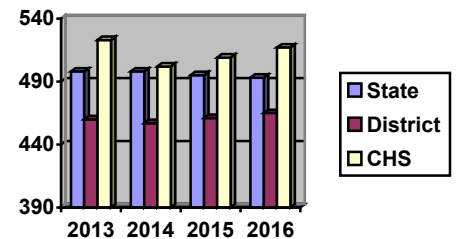

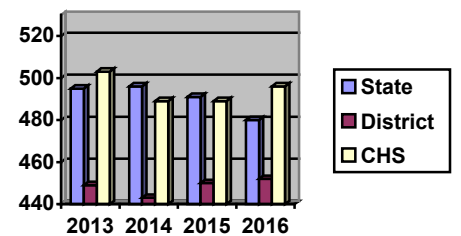
Average SAT Math Score
