The STUDENT agrees to:

- ❖ **Come to class and be on time.**
- ❖ Bring all materials to class – notebook, pens, pencils, etc.
- ❖ **Complete all classwork on time.**
- ❖ Participate in classroom activities.
- ❖ Maintain authentic engagement for the entire class period.
- ❖ **Attend required lunch tutorial sessions weekly – I have tutorials on _____ and _____ lunches.**
- ❖ **End the second nine weeks of the semester with a final grade at or above a 65.**
- ❖ **Make up work as identified on attached sheet.**

The PARENT/GUARDIAN agrees to:

- ❖ Follow up at home to see that assignments are being completed.
- ❖ Access the parent portal on PowerSchool to monitor student progress.
- ❖ Use email and/or telephone calls to contact teacher to check on the academic progress in this class.

The TEACHER agrees to:

- ❖ Be available for help during lunch tutorials.
- ❖ Update the student’s grade PowerSchool by the end of every week.

Progress will be assessed when interim reports are issued and at the end of the semester. Consequences for not fulfilling this contract include the retention of the original average along with the possibility of failing this course, which would cause the student to need to repeat this course and to fall behind in graduation requirements. The student’s efforts to solve this problem will be considered complete when the student, parent/guardian, and teacher have completed the above requirements. It should also be noted that a student’s final grade in this course will be determined by his/her first semester grade (40%), second semester grade (40%), and final exam grade (20%). Therefore, the student will also need to do well on his/her final exam.
