

**LEGAL NOTICE  
INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed bids for the application of a new roofing system at Midland High School, 1830 State Route 17, Varna, IL 61375, will be received by the Board of Education of Midland Community Unit School District No. 7, Marshall County, Illinois, with work to begin June 1, 2019, and substantial completion no later than August 9, 2019.

Bids are due at its office at Administration Building, 901 Hilltop Drive, Sparland, IL 61565, by 2:00 p.m. central prevailing time on Friday, February 15, 2019. Bids will be opened and read aloud at that time. The specifications and invitation for bids will be available from Superintendent Mr. Bill Wrenn at the Administration Building, 901 Hilltop Drive, Sparland, IL 61565, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning Monday, January 28, 2019. A walk-through and pre-bid meeting will be conducted on Thursday, February 7, 2019, at 1:00 p.m. at Midland High School, 1830 State Route 17, Varna, IL 61375; attendance is encouraged but not mandatory. Bidders must submit all questions regarding the specifications and invitation for bids in writing to Mr. Wrenn at [bwrenn@midland-7.net](mailto:bwrenn@midland-7.net) or the address listed above. Replies will be issued to all bidders of record in the form of an Addendum. Questions received after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 8, 2019, cannot be answered. Prevailing wage rates will apply and must be included in the bid amount.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a bid bond or a certified check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid. Each bidder expressly agrees that such bid may not be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days from the opening thereof. Withdrawal within such period shall subject the bidder to forfeiture of the bid security and penalties and damages to the District to the extent that such withdrawal results in loss to the District and may result in disqualification from future bids.

The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all bids or any part thereof, to waive any informalities, errors or irregularity in bids received or in the bidding process, and to accept the bid that the Board of Education deems the most favorable to its interest after all bids have been examined and canvassed. The Board of Education will award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder that meets the criteria as established in the specifications and the contract will be awarded only after a formal notice is given to the successful bidder pursuant to action by the Board of Education.
