- To locate and identify unserved handicap children, ages birth to 21 who live in the Wilson School District.
- To increase the general populations's awareness of public schools services for school age children;
- Wilson Public Schools is responsible to inform parents of their rights under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 and IDEA-B regarding personally identification process; and
- To work with Oklahoma State Department of Education is assessing the need for future programs and in planning programs which will provide for a free an appropriate education for all handicapped children.
