Information and Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines carefully. The permission form is not valid unless ALL signature blanks are completed. Tickets may not be purchased without signed and completed permission form. This activity is only for Kalaheo juniors and seniors as determined by the registrar. Seniors who have not completed your PTP folder you will not be allowed to attend prom.

1. Pay your school fees and clear all obligations including detentions and disciplinary obligations before ticket sales start. Mr. Lau, Mrs. Koopman, Mrs. Dichner, Ms. Sato, Mrs. Gumapac, and Mr. Pregitzer will have the outstanding obligations list by March 2nd so students can ask if they have obligations. You may also see the account clerk during recess or lunch at the accounting window in the downstairs H-building courtyard.

If you have obligations, bring your prom permission form to accounting window in H-building courtyard during recess and lunch only and pay for your obligations to receive an authorized signature for clearance. You must have your student ID with you to pay your obligations. Payments for obligations will not be accepted after school during prom ticket sales. If your guest is a Kalaheo student, he or she must also clear all obligations.
Please clear obligations by February 28, 2020.

2. **Ticket sales will be held at the downstairs H-Building courtyard after school on the following dates:**

February 19 Early Ticket Sales	\$85 for Kalaheo Junior & Seniors \$90 for Guests*
March 10-12 Regular Ticket Sales	\$95 for Kalaheo Junior & Seniors \$100 for Guests*
March 24 Late Ticket Sales (cash only)	\$105 for Kalaheo Junior & Seniors \$110 for Guests*

A current Kalaheo student I.D. card is required to purchase tickets. Tickets are sold on a first come, first-served basis. Ticket price includes buffet dinner, dancing, decorations, favors, other activities and other prom expenses.

* Kalaheo Juniors and Seniors may sponsor one guest. A guest may be a Kalaheo Sophomore, a student from another high school in grades 10-12, or someone who is 20 years old or younger. **Persons who are 21 and older or Freshmen (as determined by the registrar) or younger are not permitted to attend the prom.** Guests who are not Kalaheo students must complete an additional agreement attached to the permission form before purchasing tickets.

3. ALL Chapter 19 and school rules will apply to students and guests throughout the event. Kalaheo students are responsible for communicating school rules and prom guidelines to their guests.
4. Kalaheo students must NOT have been suspended from school on April 24th or April 27th in order to attend Prom. A suspension will result in cancellation of the tickets (student and guest) and no refund will be issued.
5. Once a ticket has been purchased, there will be absolutely **no refund**. Tickets are non-transferable; tickets cannot be sold or given to another person. Entry to the prom is based on the guest list.

6. Table sign-up forms will be accepted from March 27-29. **No changes will be allowed once seating is assigned.** The student and their sponsored guest must sit on the same table. You may not sign up people on your table without their permission. Download the form on the Kalaheo website (www.kalaheohigh.org) and bring completed form to room L202 or to Ms. Sato's box in the office by March 24. Forms will be available at ticket sales. Tables will be assigned in the order received. Participants who do not sign up will be assigned to a table by the prom committee.
7. The Junior and Senior Prom will be held in the Regency Ballrooms at the Hyatt Regency Waikiki Beach Resort at 2424 Kalaukua Avenue, Honolulu, Hawaii 96815. Parking is available at \$8 for self parking and \$12 for valet. From Kuhio Avenue traveling towards Diamond Head, turn right onto Uluniu Avenue (one-way street) and the parking entrance will be on the left. The ballroom is in the same structure as the parking.
8. The doors open at 5:30pm. Check-in will be from 5:30-6:45pm. Dinner will begin at 7:00pm. **Do not be late. Leave home early and anticipate heavy traffic getting into Waikiki. No one will be allowed into the ballroom after 7:00pm. No exceptions. No refunds given.** If you will be late and it is unavoidable, you must see Ms. Sato in L202 before April 19th. **All guests must check in with the sponsoring Kalaheo student.**
9. Kalaheo students must have a current student I.D. and non-Kalaheo students must have a valid government or school photo I.D. to check in at the prom. Students and guests who do not have proper photo ID cards will not be allowed to attend the event. Parents are not allowed to call the hotel to verify identification.
10. Backpacks, large bags, and packages will NOT be permitted into the ballroom. Do not bring any contraband items including weapons, alcohol, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, or other drugs. Refer to Kalaheo Disciplinary Handbook and Chapter 19 for clarification.
11. **All students and guests are required to stay for entire duration of prom.** Students leaving the event before 10:30pm will receive disciplinary consequences, unless the parent or guardian makes arrangements with Kalaheo staff at the prom and come to pick up the student from the ballroom. If you and your guest leave the prom without your parent, you will not be allowed to return, your parent will be notified and the school is absolved of all responsibility.
12. Picture taking will begin at 5:30pm. Please make checks payable to Halemano Photography. Picture-taking information will be distributed at ticket sales.
13. **DRESS CODE for Prom is Formal Attire.** Attire will be strictly monitored at the doors. Anyone not in appropriate formal attire will not be allowed to attend the prom. No refunds given. If you are unsure about your outfit, please bring it to Ms. Sato in (L202) for approval.

<p>FORMAL ATTIRE: Gowns, fancy short dresses required with appropriate dress shoes or formal footwear. Cut-outs in appropriate areas covered with mesh or other material are permitted with approval from Ms. Sato. Skin must not be exposed in the cut-outs. Strapless or two-piece gowns are permitted as long as midriff is not exposed. Dress length or slit must be at least finger tip length</p> <p>Tuxedo, suit or coat and tie required. Dress pants, long sleeve collared shirt. Formal hats are allowed, but not baseball caps, beanies, etc. Dress shoes preferred. Shoes that are not dress shoes that meet these criteria are permitted: closed toe, mostly one color, clean, and not worn out.</p> <p>If you have questions about the attire, please see Ms. Sato or Mrs. Koopman in advance of the Prom.</p>	<p>School Dress Code Enforced. No overly revealing attire: low-cut necklines, low back (material must extend to belly button line), high slits (no higher than finger tip length), extremely short dresses or skirts (no shorter than finger tip length), no tube dresses made of stretchy material, no exposed midriff, see-through material, or holes or openings in any area that should be covered. Underwear, under shirts, or any under garments must not be exposed. Clothing must be in good taste. Sun glasses are not allowed. Please see Ms. Sato if you're unsure if your attire will be appropriate for Prom.</p>	<p>ABSOLUTELY NO CASUAL ATTIRE. The following are not allowed: t-shirts, shorts, leggings, yoga pants, slippers, athletic shoes, sweats, baggy pants, aloha shirt, jeans, polo shirt, baseball caps, beanies, bandanas, rags, flannel and any other clothing deemed not formal.</p> <p>This is a formal event. Dress appropriately!</p> <p>Students and guests dressed inappropriately will be denied entry into the prom.</p>
