Examination/Grading/Rating

Student academic achievement and citizenship shall be evaluated, recorded and reported each marking period. Students, parents/guardians and appropriate school personnel will be informed of the student's progress.

A written report shall be sent to or a conference shall be held with the student's parent/guardian in the event the student is in danger of failing the course. (Education Code 49067)

In an attempt to establish a complete understanding of the reasons for an initial grade assignment in question, prior to taking formal action, the Superintendent or designee shall consult with the teacher who assigned the student's grade.

Failing grades shall be assigned for excessive absences in accordance with BP 5113. Such grades shall be designated accordingly in the student's records. (Education Code 49067)
