



First Commonwealth Bank Scholarship Program Overview

Value: A total of \$35,000 is available in \$1,000 individual scholarships.

Eligibility: Graduating high school seniors with a 3.00 GPA (or an 85% average) or better.

Applicant must be graduating from a high school located in one of the following counties in Pennsylvania (Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Blair, Butler, Cambria, Clearfield, Elk, Indiana, Jefferson, Lawrence, Somerset, Washington and Westmoreland) or Ohio (Ashtabula, Clermont, Delaware, Franklin, Hamilton, Madison and Stark).

Requirements: Applicant must complete an essay (500 words or less) detailing how the student put their community first by being engaged in community support activities and how they put their academics first by excelling in the classroom.

Deadlines: Applications must be received by 5:00 p.m. on March 1, 2019. Winners will be notified by April 20, 2019.

All decisions will be final. First Commonwealth will have the rights to all stories submitted for promotional purposes.
