National Honor Society: Marina High School Chapter Selection Guidelines

National Honor Society (NHS) was founded on the ideals of scholarship, character, leadership, and service. Candidates may submit Information Forms for membership consideration on an annual basis. Membership is open to students enrolled in 10th, 11th, and 12th grade. All members will receive a certificate of membership each year. Senior members are recognized at the Honors Night Ceremony. Annual chapter membership is \$10(cash only) paid to the Marina High School financial aid office after notification of induction to the chapter.

Scholarship

The minimum scholarship requirement for the Marina High School NHS chapter is a cumulative weighted grade point average of 3.60 and above.

Character

NHS defines a person of character as one who demonstrates the six qualities of trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Students will demonstrate character through the service activities and leadership experiences they have participated. The chapter advisor will review administrative records and documentation for discipline, attendance, and citizenship marks.

Leadership

The Marina High School NHS chapter defines *leadership role* as a position of responsibility in the classroom, at work, or in other school or community; where the individual is directly responsible for directing or motivating others to perform a specific activity or task. To meet the leadership criterion for NHS, a student must name a specified number of leadership roles at school or in the community. Leadership roles must begin prior to the school-year that the student is currently enrolled. Students will name all leadership roles achieved since the ninth grade and indicate the roles and the name and signature of the adult who supervised each of these activities on the Information Form. The minimum leadership role(s) required for consideration is based on the grade level of the applicant:

- 10th grade: one leadership role (completed in 9th grade)
- 11th grade: two leadership roles * **
- 12th grade: three leadership roles * **

*One leadership role over 2-3 years is acceptable.

**Current 11th grade and 12th grade students may use one current leadership role to meet the criterion

Service

The Marina High School NHS chapter defines *service* as volunteer activities at school or in the community done with or on behalf of others without compensation, reward, or educational credit. Paid employment activities will not be considered as service activity hours. Service hours must be completed prior to the start of the school year which the student is currently enrolled. Students will describe all service activities, the hours contributed to each activity, and provide the name and signature of the adult who supervised the service hours on the Information Form. The minimum cumulative service hours required for consideration is based on the grade level of the applicant:

- 10th grade: 10 hours
- 11th grade: 25 hours
- 12th grade: 45 hours
