## 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Required Classes

All 9<sup>th</sup> graders will take courses in the following subjects:

- Language Arts *Honors and basics levels are available*
- College Preparatory Math (CPM) *Honors levels and basic math skills classes are available as needed; final placement based on successful completion of previous math course. High school level math courses are called Secondary Math*
- Science *Options include Biology or Earth Science*
- Social Studies *The 9<sup>th</sup> grade course is called World Geography; honors is available*
- Digital Studies (on-line) *This class fulfills a High School requirement*

## Highly Recommended Classes

Taking a Foreign Language course in Jr. High is great preparation for high school Foreign Language courses. Studying at least 2 years of a Foreign Language in High School is recommended and often required by colleges and universities. If you are taking Spanish 1 this year, consider continuing it in 9<sup>th</sup> grade by taking Spanish 2.

## 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Elective Options

You will have the option to take any combination of full and half year elective classes that add up to 3.5 credits. Full year classes give 1.0 credit and half year classes give 0.5 credit. Look for classes that match your interests and will help you prepare for classes you hope to take in the future. Also, consider taking elective courses that will help you meet specific high school graduation requirements, such as Participation Skills for PE credit. Online courses may be taken, but MUST be coordinated with the school counselor. Auditions for advanced Fine Arts courses are held in May..
