Food Service Update

March 24, 2020

Dear Clio Parents/Guardians:

Clio Area Schools will continue to provide our daily meal program this week and implement changes to provide meals to all of our students next week (spring break). I have summarized the program below:

- Meals, including a breakfast and a lunch, will be available from 10:00 am until 1:00 pm each day through Friday at Clio High School, Garner Elementary School, Clio Church of God, and Clio New Covenant Church. All children aged 0 - 18 are eligible to receive meals. Special needs students up to the age of 26 are also eligible. Parents who wish to have meals delivered should contact their building principal.

Clio Schools will implement a home delivery plan on **Thursday and Friday to provide food for students over spring break**. The details of the plan are as follows:

BREAKFASTS:

- All students who regularly ride the bus to or from school, or who have been scheduled to ride a bus, will receive five (5) breakfasts on Thursday. The breakfasts will be delivered via school bus and delivery will begin at 8 am. Breakfasts will be prepackaged and will be dropped off on the porch of most residences in order to minimize contact.

Students/parents who reside in Maple Run may pick up breakfasts from the bus which will be parked near the office from 8:30 am - 9:30 am. Students who reside in the Pine Creek Apartments and Pine Ridge Apartments will be able to pick up breakfasts from the bus which will be parked near the main entrance from 9:15-9:25. Students that reside in Pine Forrest may pick up breakfast between 8:30-8:45 at the main entrance of the trailer park.

We will provide breakfasts for additional children in your household between the ages of 0-18, or up to age 26 if a special needs student, if parents contact ndaniels@clioschools.org. Parents must provide Nancy with the current bus rider's name, address, phone number, and the number of additional children that need breakfasts/lunches.

Students who walk to Clio High School or Carter Middle School may pick up breakfasts from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm on Thursday.

- All students who regularly ride the bus to or from school, or who have been scheduled to ride a bus, will receive five (5) lunches on Friday. The lunches will be delivered via school bus and delivery will begin at 2:00 pm. Lunches will be prepackaged and will be dropped off on the porch of most residences in order to minimize contact.

Students who reside in Maple Run may pick up lunches at the bus which will be parked near the office from 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm. Students who reside in the Pine Creek Apartments and the Pine Ridge Apartments will be able to pick up lunches from the bus which will be parked near the main entrance from 2:15 pm - 2:25 pm. Students that reside in Pine Forrest will be able to pick up lunch between 2:30 and 2:45.

We will provide meals for additional children in your household between the ages of 0-18, or up to age 26 if a special needs student, if parents contact ndaniels@clioschools.org. Parents must provide Nancy with the current bus riders name, address, phone number, and the number of additional children that need lunches.

Students who walk to Clio High School or Carter Middle School may pick up lunches on Friday from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Parents are encouraged to drive up to the school and remain in the car to pick up the food.

Our goal is to ensure that all of our children are provided with meals during the Monday through Friday break next week. Questions may also be directed to the superintendent by calling (810) 591-7490.
