- Parents reviewed the school's StriveHI Report for SY 2017-18, as well as the library bulletin board on which students had posted their ideas of actions that they could do to create a better world.
- During parent-teacher conferences, it was challenging and created a hardship for some families to be able to adjust to the one-hour early dismissal over the nine days. A suggestion was to follow the schedule at another complex elementary school of holding the conferences over two full days which minimize the number of school days impacted.
- Explore the possibilities of providing the students with different engineering and technology opportunities throughout the school day (ex. robotics). Find ways to embed them within the curriculum rather than as afterschool programs which come with a fee.
- Provide opportunities for families to be informed regarding the activities/lessons that are going on in the resource classes. It is an exciting day that the students look forward to, yet the families are not aware of what goes on in the classes. A suggestion is to have student work be sent home from the different resource classes.
