Eric Leeworthy: Award: not specified. Minimum 3.0 gpa, must have lettered in a varsity sport. Submit transcript, letter of recommendation, and essay (350-500 words): *Describe a meaningful volunteer experience*

Jim Welch Scholarship: Award: Two-\$2000 scholarships for a GHS and an LRHS student who will be pursuing a career in the agriculture industry.

County of Sacramento: Award: not specified. For students with financial need. Minimum gpa 2.5, must submit proof of public assistance or if not on public assistance, submit IRS tax form 1040. Susie Gaynes-Mitchell Scholarship: Award: 6-\$1000 scholarships. Must have a minimum 2.5 gpa, entering a 2-4 yr college or technical/trade school. Due April 19, 2019 to address listed on application

Galt Lions Community Service Scholarship: Award: \$250-750. For students who have made community service part of their high school experience. Must complete application and essay. 500-word essay on either *1) How I helped my community with my service OR 2) How my community service has affected my outlook on life.*

January 22, 2019

Hadley Marie Hubbard Memorial: (GHS only): Award: \$2000 given to a female (or male in alternating years) graduating in 2019 who is planning to pursue a health related field. 3.5 minimum gpa, 4 yr college bound, copy of SAT/ACT, Essay: *What major will you be pursuing and how will you give back to your community after you graduate? How will this scholarship help you?*

James F. Nunes Scholarship for the Performing Arts: Award: up to \$1500. Must be planning to attend 2- or 4-yr college or Performing Arts School. Drama/Theatre participants will have priority. No minimum gpa required. Required: letter of recommendation from Performing Arts teacher, transcript, and Essay: *How is art a significant part of your life? What are your future plans? What impact did your performing arts classes have on your future plans?*

January 15, 2019

Cal Waste Vocational Scholarship: Award: \$500. For students who will enroll in a career/vocational certificate or degree program in Fall 2019. This is including but not limited to Heavy Machinery, Diesel Mechanics, Welding, Automotive Technology, Electrical, and other applied science, technology, and agricultural areas or business courses supporting these fields. This scholarship is need based rather than grade based.

January 14, 2019

Liberty Ranch Athletic Boosters: LRHS only. For students who have participated in a CIF athletic program and is an athlete during his/her senior year in good standing according to CIF guidelines. **Due April 21, 2019 to Coach Linebaugh.**

Galt Sunrise Rotary: Award: \$500. Minimum 3.0 gpa, personal statement, transcript, SAT/ACT (for 4-yr college applicants). Personal statement required. See application for topic.
