Volunteers are approved for two years. However, over the summer all approved volunteers receive an email which requires a reply to keep their status active. Please check your junk mail and spam folders. Volunteers with an expiration date of 09/01/2018 have a grace period ending 10/01/2018. LATE BUSES—Thank you for your patience as the district works through bus routes, overflow buses and making sure all students are on correct buses. We apologize that we have had late buses the first several days of school. You can be assured this will gradually improve over the next week. We share a bus loop and buses with Liberty Creek. Please expect some delays on Monday and Tuesday of next week as Kindergarten begins. If you have questions or concerns about your child's bus and cannot reach our front office after the office closes at 4:00pm, please contact Transportation at 558-5490. We will continue to use our blackboard system to update parents regarding late buses.
