Tips for Creating a Safe Super Secret Password

- * Spell a word backwards. (Example: Turn "New York" into "kroywen".)
- * Randomly throw in some capital letters and punctuation marks.
- * Choose some random words that don't normally go together (Example: correcthorsebatterystaple)
- * Use an acronym from a phrase of your choice. "We didn't start the fire, it was always burning" becomes "wdstfiwab" based on the first letters of each word
- * Interchange numbers and letters, for example the word Gregory could be Gregg0ry, inserting a number zero for the letter "o" in Gregory
- * Remember, the longer the password, the stronger it is.
