

## **English Learners (EL's)**

Connecticut and federal statutes governing the education of English Learners (ELs) require the assessment and identification of all students who enter Park City Prep Charter School. The Language Assessment System (LAS Links), Formal Observation, and the English Language Interview are used by Park City Prep to identify such students as English Learners during each school year.

Park City Prep Charter School offers a program of instructional support to students who qualify as English Learners to assist them in acquiring English language in the regular education class without pull-out support.

Any English Learner who is eligible for an Individualized Education Program (IEP) for a child with a disability has the right to receive a free, appropriate public education as outlined in the (IEP) which is designed to meet the child's unique learning and language needs.

Parents are notified in writing during each school year regarding the assessment and the identification of their child as an EL student.

As a parent, you have the right to refuse or remove your child from the EL support. If you have any questions about the placement of your child for this school year, please contact Ms. Daisy Martinez-DiCarlo, School Counselor and EL Coordinator.
