



## ***SUMMER READING 2019 – ENGLISH 10***

English 10 Students must:

- Read *The Hunger Games* by Suzanne Collins
- Read *Kindred* by Octavia Butler (*read this novel after completing The Hunger Games*)
- Complete the assignment below for *Kindred*

The novel *Kindred* is written in the first person – Dana recounts her own experiences. Your job is to assume the identity of Dana and write a series of journal entries, relating those experiences and reacting to them.

In each journal entry you should summarize what happened to “you” (you being Dana) in the assigned chapter, and react to it emotionally.

You must write a total of seven (7) journal entries:

- One that speaks about the events in the chapter entitled “The River”.
- One that speaks about the events in the chapter “The Fire”.
- One that speaks about the events in the chapter “The Fall”.
- One that speaks about the events in the chapter “The Fight”.
- One that speaks about the events in the chapter “The Storm”.
- One that speaks about the events in the chapter “The Rope”.
- And finally, one written after the Epilogue, in which you recount the events from that chapter, and react to the events of the book as a whole.

Each entry should be one-to-two pages long, double-spaced, in twelve-point Times New Roman font, with one-inch margins.

This project is due on the first day of class, on which day you will also take a summer reading test on *both* books
