### Title I Schoolwide Program Parent Compact

Montour Elementary School has been granted schoolwide Title I. status from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE). The schoolwide format is usually reserved for those schools where at least 40% of the student population comes from low-income families. However, the District was granted a waiver to the provision from PDE to adopt a schoolwide Title I. program so that all students can receive additional reading and math services as needed.

The Montour Elementary School Title I. Reading Program provides additional support and instruction by appropriately state certified personnel. As a parent, it is your right to request and review the documentation that supports this status.

In the schoolwide Title I. format, the district must identify students in need of interventions through the use of objective assessments and rank order. All students are eligible for supplemental intervention services.
